

CONTEST GUIDELINES

To be eligible, contestants must be a high school student classified as a senior as of the essay contest entry deadline of 5:00 p.m. on January 21, 2022. Students must also live in a home served by Wise Electric Cooperative to be eligible. The travel dates are June 12-21, 2022. All essays become property of WEC. **All participants must have COVID card showing 2 shots.**

Contestants must deliver the essay to the Cooperative office by 5:00 p.m. on January 21, 2022. The essay must be an original composition by the student on one of the following topics: (1) What are the advantages of receiving electric service from a cooperative compared with an investor owned utility, (2) How the availability of electric service improves the quality of life in Rural Texas, or (3) Interview a Cooperative Member who remembers when they received power for the first time. Essays should include a cover page (this page) with the information required (see below). For purposes of judging, the essay itself and inside pages should carry only two identification marks: the students Social Security Number and the essay title.

The finalists will be asked to go through an interview process with a panel of judges on Tuesday, February 15, 2022, at the cooperative's headquarters in Decatur, Texas. The top two candidates will be awarded the trip to Washington, and will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. **The winners must make the trip to Washington in order to receive the scholarship money.** The judges will also choose a runner-up who will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.
